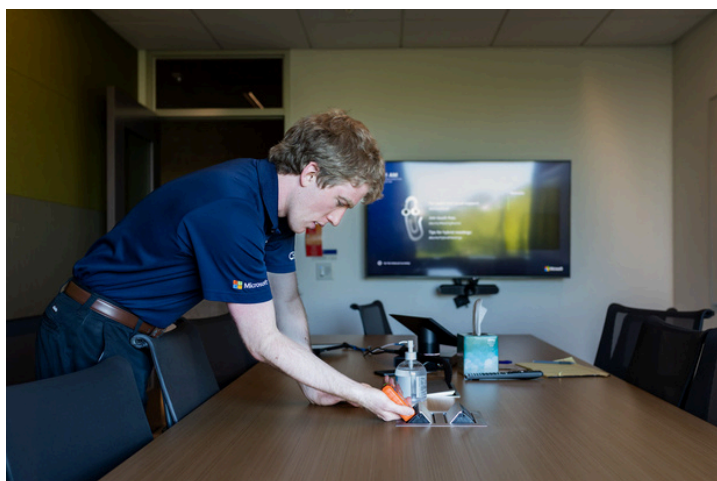
SKCAC's School-to-Work program provides students with ongoing support to promote job readiness skills including skill-building, job seeking, resume building, and finding an individualized job match.

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The School-to-Work Process

- First, set up a meeting with SKCAC to learn more about our School-to-Work program and how we can support your transition into the workforce.
- SKCAC will help determine your eligibility for our services or share ways to become eligible.
- SKCAC partners with schools to help students achieve their employment goals.
- Once eligible and a service agreement is in place, we'll get to know you through school and community assessments to better understand your skills, gifts, career interests, and professional development goals.
- SKCAC will provide training and support with interview preparation, resume building, goal setting, meeting employers, and opportunities to practice work skills before employment.
- SKCAC provides ongoing support through continuous communication, individualized job coaching, advocacy for accommodations in the workplace, and support to meet employer expectations.
